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Sahil asks:

Juhi, what should I check before sending money to someone online?

Juhi explains:

First, confirm exactly who you're paying and why. If the request is unexpected, contact the person or company another way before sending anything.

JUHI'S ACTION: Verify the recipient independently.

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Sahil asks:

What if the message really looks like it came from someone I know?

Juhi explains:

Don't rely only on the name, photo, email address, or message history. Accounts can be hacked or impersonated. Call the person using a number you already trust if the request seems unusual.

JUHI'S ACTION: Confirm unusual requests outside the message.

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Sahil asks:

Should I worry if they say the payment is urgent?

Juhi explains:

Yes, especially if they pressure you to pay immediately or tell you not to contact anyone. Urgency can be used to stop you from checking the story.

JUHI'S ACTION: Slow down when someone pressures you.

Sahil asks:

What should I check before pressing "Send"?

Juhi explains:

Carefully review the recipient's name or account details and the amount. A small mistake could send your money to the wrong person.

JUHI'S ACTION: Check the recipient and amount twice.

Sahil asks:

Does the payment method matter?

Juhi explains:

Yes. Some payment methods offer more protection than others, and some transfers can be difficult to reverse. Check what protections and cancellation options apply before paying.

JUHI'S ACTION: Understand the payment method first.

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Sahil asks:

What if someone asks me to pay with gift cards or cryptocurrency?

Juhi explains:

Be especially cautious when an unexpected request demands gift cards, cryptocurrency, or another hard-to-reverse payment method. Verify the request independently before doing anything.

JUHI'S ACTION: Treat unusual payment demands as a warning sign.

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Sahil asks:

What about paying someone I met through an online marketplace?

Juhi explains:

Follow the marketplace's official payment process when available. Be cautious if someone tries to move the payment outside the platform or sends you an unfamiliar payment link.

JUHI'S ACTION: Stay with the platform's official payment system.

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Sahil asks:

Is it safe to click a payment link someone sends me?

Juhi explains:

Not automatically. A link can lead to a fake payment or login page. When possible, open the official app or type the trusted website address yourself.

JUHI'S ACTION: Avoid unexpected payment links.

Sahil asks:

Should I keep anything after I make a payment?

Juhi explains:

Yes. Keep the receipt or transaction confirmation, along with important messages about what you paid for. They may help if there is a dispute or problem later.

JUHI'S ACTION: Save proof of the transaction.

Sahil asks:

What if I realize I sent money to a scammer or the wrong person?

Juhi explains:

Contact your bank, card issuer, payment service, or other provider immediately and ask what options are available. If fraud is involved, follow the official reporting process where you live.

JUHI'S ACTION: Report the problem as quickly as possible.

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Juhi's Quick Check

- Before pressing SEND, ask:
- Do I know exactly who is receiving the money?
- Did I independently verify an unusual request?
- Did I check the recipient details and amount?
- Do I understand the payment method?
- Am I being pressured to act quickly?
- Am I using the official app, website, or payment system?
- Can I save proof of the transaction?

Simple Rule

Remember

Verify the person, payment details, and reason before you press Send. Money can move faster than mistakes can be fixed.

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
